A new hybrid candidate that has performed well in official trials (106%, 44.7% oil) and is under test this year in Agrii trials where it has shown excellent crop vigour so far.

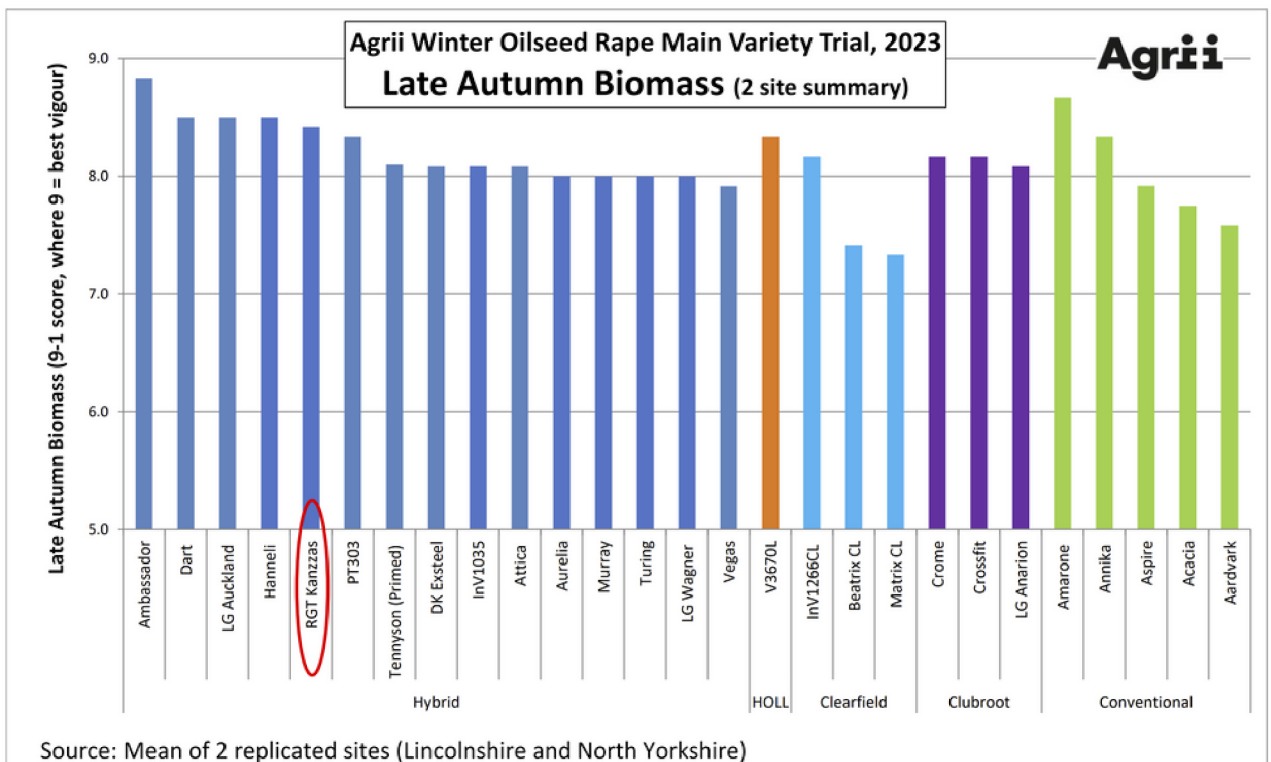
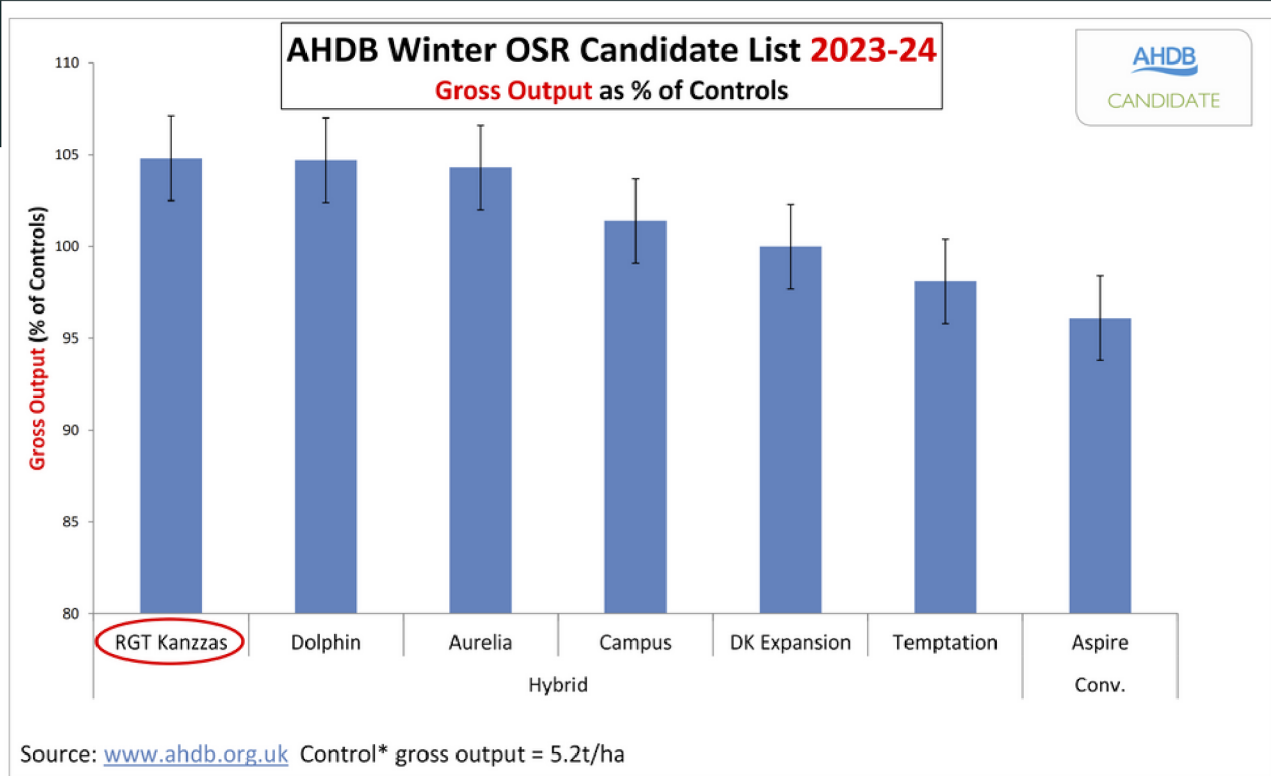
Suitable for all soil types and while it is under evaluation by the AHDB in the East and West regions, it is being tested by Agrii across the UK. Relatively tall (157 cm) but very good stem stiffness (8) and excellent lodging resistance (8) and relatively early maturity.

It has reasonable stem canker/phoma resistance (6) and excellent resistance against the more important and progressive disease, light leaf spot (8). The breeder does not claim either pod shatter or TuVY resistance but other varieties in the Agrii portfolio continue to perform at the top level without these traits. Verticillium wilt will be assessed this autumn.
