Variety Positioning

- A popular variety at both ends of the country. Average yields but a very consistent performer producing grain of good specific weight but slightly lower than average kernel content.
- Tall straw of average strength, Canyon is slightly earlier to mature than average, although there is little to choose between most varieties.
- Very good Mildew resistance and average Crown Rust resistance.
