



**MV Fredericia is the first variety to be introduced
to the UK market by Angus Wheat Consultants Ltd.**

The variety (previously coded as AWC-13 and now with the proposed name of Mv Fredericia) was bred in Hungary by the Agricultural Institute, Hungarian Academy of Sciences in Martonvasar, Hungary.

The variety offers a number of high value traits, usually only present in single varieties, combined together in a plant type that will suit UK growers.

The variety has excellent breadmaking quality and has early maturity - which is a prerequisite for establishing oilseed rape. The variety has good resistance to the major foliar wheat diseases with a particular strength in Septoria resistance. Preliminary trials by Agrii indicate that the variety is very competitive in blackgrass scenarios – a reflection of its rapid spring development.

The new AWC variety is of special interest to East Anglian growers. This is the bread basket of the UK, and it provides the highest chances of meeting UK bread specifications in the driest part of the country with good sunshine levels.
