

Green Horizons Agrii Innovation Award 2021

Award Terms & Conditions

1. The Agrii Innovation Award scheme is open to Agrii customers and members of staff who are residents of the UK, Channel Islands and Isle of Man.
2. For the purposes of this award scheme, an Agrii customer is defined as someone who has an Agrii account number, an active customer account, and has traded with us in the last two years.
3. All information detailing how to enter this award scheme forms part of these terms and conditions. It is a condition of entry that all rules are accepted as final and that the entrant agrees to abide by these rules. The decision of the judges is final and no correspondence will be entered into. Submission of an entry will be taken to mean acceptance of these terms and conditions.
4. An 'entrant' is defined as the person whose contact details are submitted on the entry form. One entrant may submit multiple entries if they wish.
5. Entries will only be accepted through the entry form on the Agrii website at <https://www.agrii.co.uk/greenhorizons/agrii-innovation-award/>. The award scheme will open on Tuesday 6th April 2021 at 9am and close on Saturday 31st July, 2021 at 5pm.
6. The winners will be selected from all valid entries after the closing date, and will be notified by post, email or telephone by Tuesday 30th November at 5pm. There will be one award for an Agrii customer and one award for an Agrii member of staff.
7. The winners of the award scheme will receive:
 - a. A written award
 - b. A ticket for attendance at the Agrii Green Horizons Farmer Network Annual Dinner (provisional date 13th January 2022)
 - c. Depending on the idea that they have entered into the award scheme, the winner(s) might get to see their idea(s) developed by the Agrii R&D team or incorporated in Agrii trials. If this is the case, then the winner(s) will be credited as coming up with the initial idea in all publicity surrounding the inclusion of their idea in Agrii R&D work or trials. They might also receive an additional prize in the format of appropriate training or another appropriate prize dependant on the idea entered. The exact prizes will be determined by the judging panel in coordination with the Agrii R&D team at the time of judging. Any additional prize will be of a maximum value of £500.
8. The prizes as described are available on the date of publication. All prizes are non-transferable and there are no alternatives.
9. Agrii accepts no responsibility for lost or damaged entries.
10. Agrii reserves the right to cancel this award scheme or alter any of the rules at any stage, if deemed necessary in its opinion, and if circumstances arise outside of its control.
11. Entrant data is collected and held in accordance with Agrii's data protection policy. Agrii reserves the right to send marketing literature to any entrants who have not ticked the box stating that they do not wish to be contacted by Agrii.
